


St Mary's Church Old Town St Paul's Church Highfield Partners within the Hemel Hempstead Team Ministry

WELCOME

Welcome to our services today: Please join us for refreshments after the 9.30am service - these are in the church hall at St Mary's and in the Parish Room at St Paul's. If this is your first visit to us then please make yourself known to one of the Clergy or a Welcomer.

Communion: All are welcome at the Lord's Table. If you do not usually receive the Bread and Wine please come forward and bow your head for a prayer of blessing.

Receiving Communion in your seat If you might find it hard to climb the steps at the front of church (St Mary's) or to approach the altar rail (St Paul's) then please mention this to a Welcomer who can arrange for Communion to be brought to your seat.

Gluten Free Wafers & Alcohol Free Wine are available if requested before the start of the service. Please speak to a Welcomer, Churchwarden or the Virger. (See Communion in One Kind, below, if you don't request this in time).

Communion in One Kind Please remember - if you haven't requested Gluten Free or Alcohol Free Communion or you have a cold and decide not to receive from the Common Cup - that receiving in only one kind (just bread or wine) is a complete and valid Communion. (As the Councils of the Church have said: 'Christ is really present and is received whole and entire, body and blood, soul and divinity, under either species alone.') Intinction of the host (dipping the bread) is discouraged.

Giving: Please join our stewardship scheme, and either give via standing order or by the special envelopes provided. If you are a UK tax payer please also complete a GiftAid form so we can claim a refund from the Government. Please ask a Welcomer for an information pack. If you are a part of the Planned Giving Scheme paying by standing order, please remember to collect a mini-card before the Service to place in the collection.

Sound System: There is a loop system in operation, please set your hearing aid to 'T' and adjust the volume as necessary.

Parish Bible Study Group There will be no meeting in August. The next Bible Study group meeting is 3.00pm Wednesday 5th September at St Paul's.

Annual Sponsored - 'Bike & Hike'

This will be on Saturday 8th September and is organised by the Beds and Herts Historic Churches Trust. This is a non-denominational body formed to raise funds and make grants for the repair of churches and chapels of any age which are open for public Christian worship. Last year the initiative in our two counties raised £86,000 from 22 centres and £2.1 million has been raised since the start in 1992. We can participate by biking and hiking and being sponsored, by going by car to churches which are open to make a donation, by receiving visitors at opened churches especially the cyclists and hikers for their 'pitstops'. Also of course we all can participate in a key way, by sponsoring somebody who is cycling or walking.

In 2017 Hemel Hempstead raised £3,019; to give you a feel for the range, the highest was Buntingford with £9,856 and the lowest was Watford with £538. Of other local interest, Berkhamsted raised £675 and St Albans £1,977 and some towns did not participate at all.

St Mary's and St Paul's will be participating in this event again this year - sign up sheets for bikers and hikers and also for stewards will be available shortly.
